NOTIFICATION

Dated Dispur, the November, 2025

eCF No.: 638769/18: In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957), the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Assam Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2013, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, in the manner hereinafter appearing, namely:--

| Short title and Commencement | 1. | (1) These rules may be called the <i>Assam Minor Mineral Concession (Second Amendment) Rules, 2025</i> .   |
|                              |    | (2) They shall come into force on the date of their notification in the Official Gazette.  |
| Amendment of Rule 8          | 2. | In the principal Rules, in rule 8, after sub-rule (7), the following new sub-rule (8) shall be inserted, namely:-  |
|                              |    | “(8) (i) In case the land belongs to a Myadi Patta holder, the land owner may offer his land, for an area not below 20 (twenty) hectares for stone mining under the Circular Economy Based Zero Waste (CEBZW) provisions.                  |
|                              |    | (ii) Land measuring 5 hectares or more but less than 20 hectares may be leased by land owners of Myadi Patta for periods varying from 5 to 20 years. For such private leases, the provisions under sub-rule (5) of rule 5 shall not apply. |
|                              |    | (iii) For private lands, barring the provision of tendering, rest of the provisions shall apply.   |
|                              |    | (iv) Matters of determination of rent and compensation to the land owner shall be as per provisions of Chapter 8 of these rules.   |
|                              |    | (v) All statutory clearances shall apply before any mining takes place.  |
|                              |    | (vi) Any such proposed mining shall have to be included in the District Survey Report (DSR).”  |
